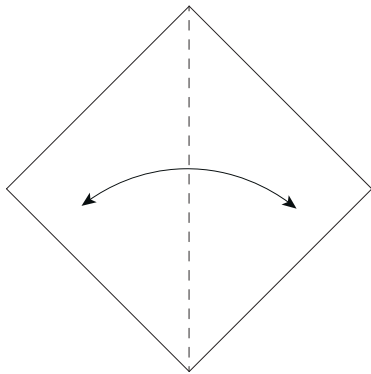


Traditional Origami Bird

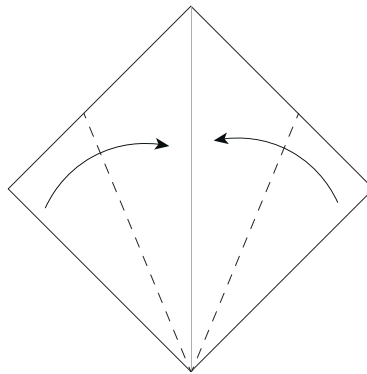

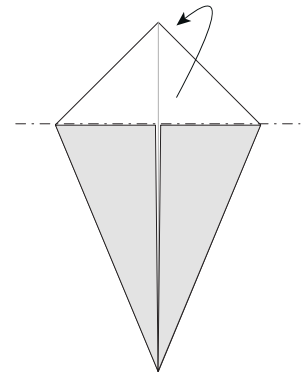

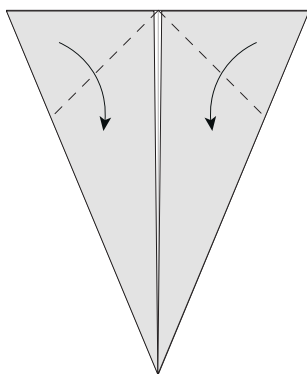
Step 1: Fold in half diagonally and unfold.



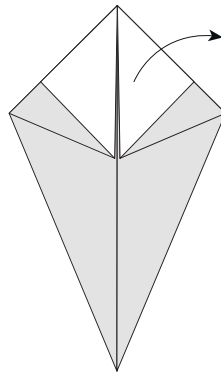
Step 2: Fold the sides to the center line.



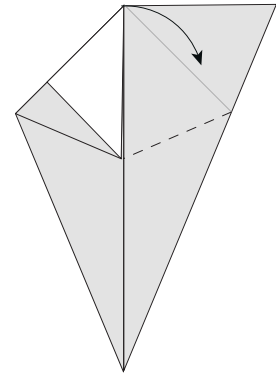
Step 3: Mountain fold the white triangular flap to the back.



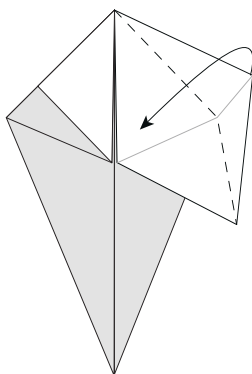
Step 4: Fold the top corners to the center line.



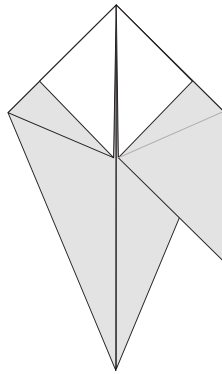
Step 5: Unfold one side.



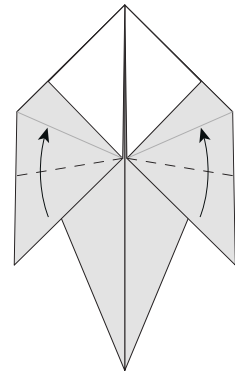
Step 6: Open the flap from the center, making a fold along the dotted line.



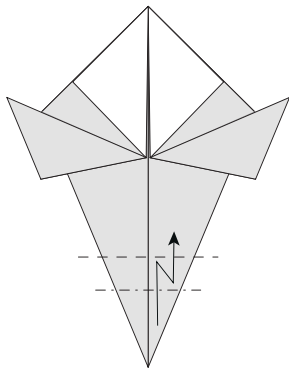
Step 7: Flatten the model by making the rightmost corner meet the center point.



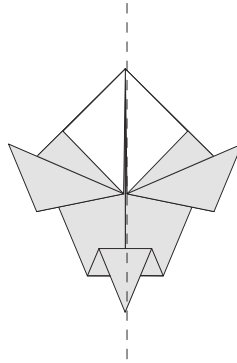
Step 8: Repeat steps 5-7 on the left side.



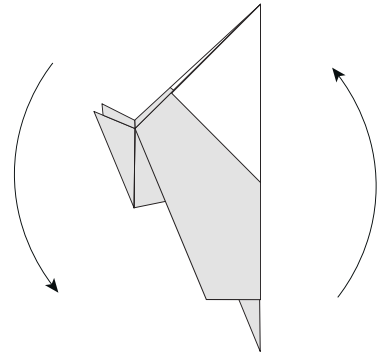
Step 9: Fold the flaps upwards.



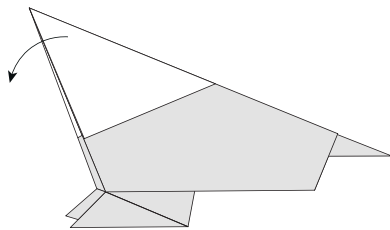
Step 10: Pleat the bottom flap.



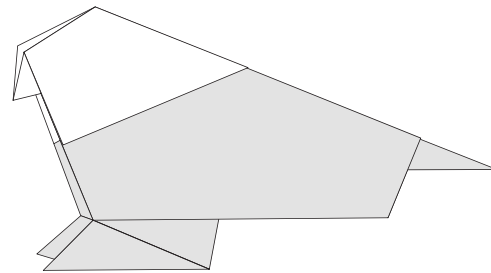
Step 11: Fold the model in half.



Step 12: Rotate the model.



Step 13: Inside reverse fold to create the beak.
