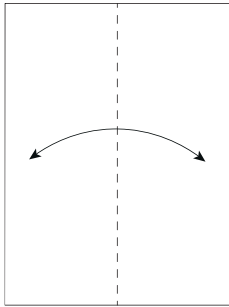


Traditional Origami Boat

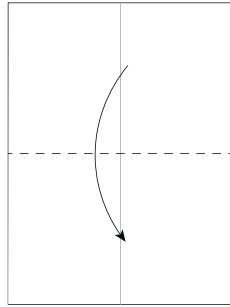

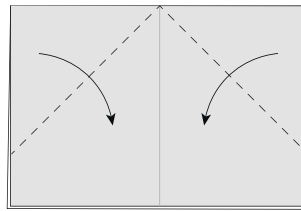

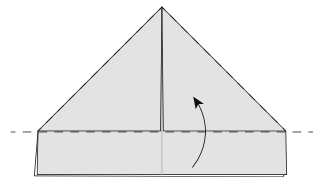
Step 1) Start with a rectangular paper of any dimensions. Fold the paper in half and then unfold it.



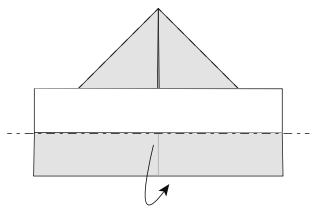
Step 2) Fold the paper in half the other way.



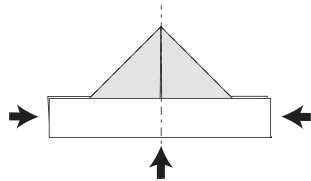
Step 3) Fold the top corners down and to the center.



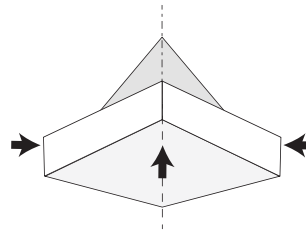
Step 4) Fold the top layer of paper up along the dotted line.



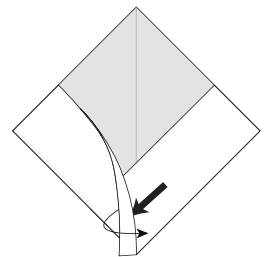
Step 5) Fold the bottom layer of paper up and behind the model.



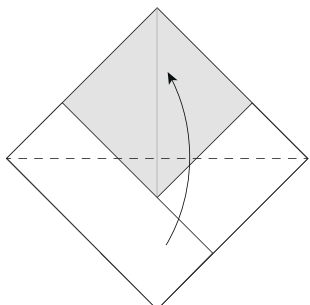
Step 6) Open up the paper from the bottom. Push in the sides while pulling the middle flaps forward and back.



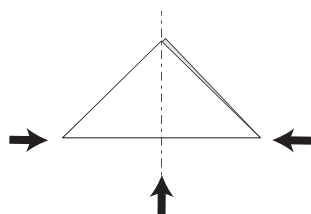
Step 7) collapse in progress.



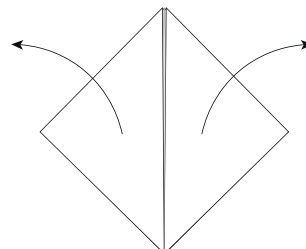
Step 8) Tuck the right flap under the left flap on both sides, flattening the model.



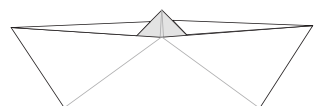
Step 9) Fold the top flap of paper up along the dotted line then repeat behind.



Step 10) Open the paper and push the sides, similar to step 6.



Step 11) Pull both ends of the paper out.



Completed boat!
