
Step 1) Start with paper white side up. Fold in half diagonally.




Step 2) Fold the corner up. There is no exact reference point for the fold




Step 3) Fold the left edge to the fold made in step 2.




Step 4) Fold the flap back down




Step 5) Fold the flap to the right. There is no exact reference point. This fold determines the size of the fish's body/tail.




Step 6) Fold the flap to the left. There is no exact reference point. This determines the size of the tail.



Step 7) Flip the model around.



Step 8) Fold down the flap to make the head.
