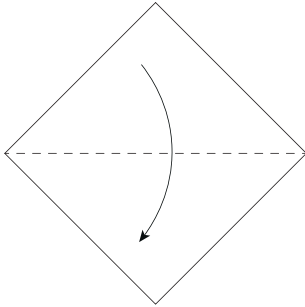


# Traditional Origami Fish

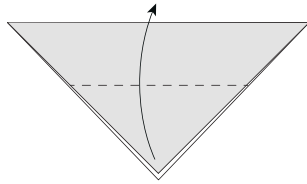

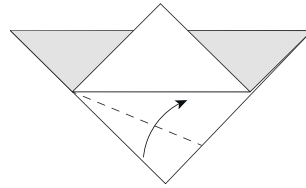

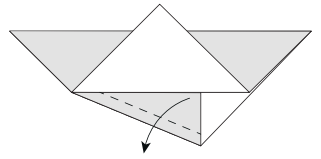
**Step 1)** Start with paper white side up. Fold in half diagonally.



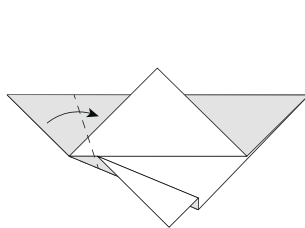
**Step 2)** Fold the corner up. There is no exact reference point for the fold.



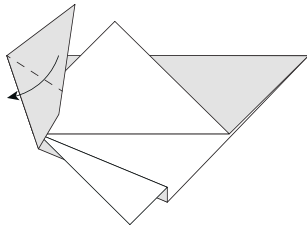
**Step 3)** Fold the left edge to the fold made in step 2.



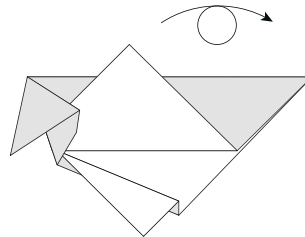
**Step 4)** Fold the flap back down.



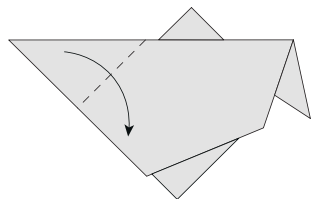
**Step 5)** Fold the flap to the right. There is no exact reference point. This fold determines the size of the fish's body/tail.



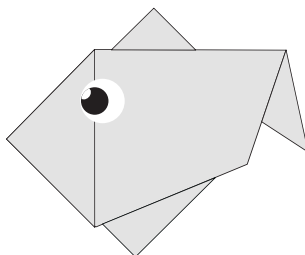
**Step 6)** Fold the flap to the left. There is no exact reference point. This determines the size of the tail.



**Step 7)** Flip the model around.



**Step 8)** Fold down the flap to make the head.
