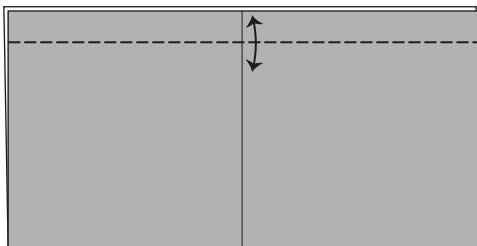
STEP 1: Start with a square paper. White side up.



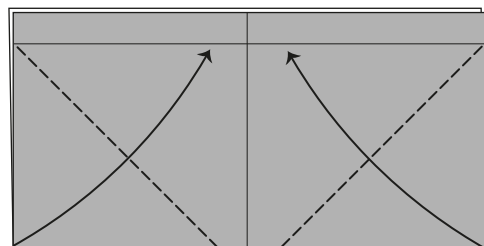
STEP 2: Fold in half vertically. Unfold.



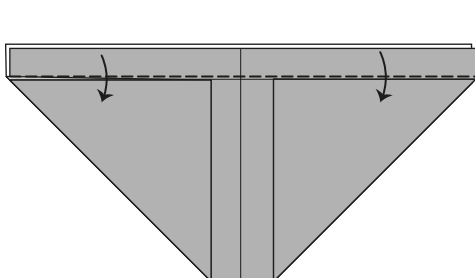
STEP 3: Fold in half horizontally



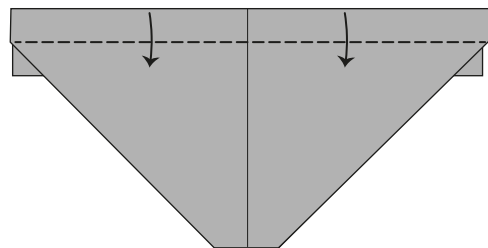
STEP 4: Fold as shown. Only the top layer. Unfold.



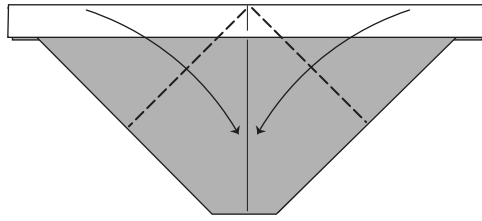
STEP 5: Fold with lower vertices joining the fold formed in the previous step.



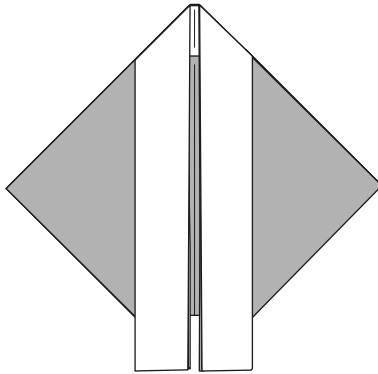
STEP 6: Fold down. Top layer only.



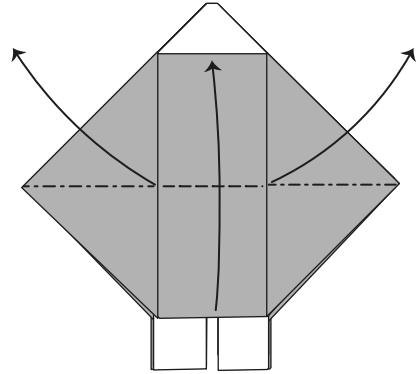
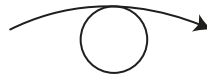
STEP 7: Flip the model. Fold as shown, aligning the fold with the crease underneath.



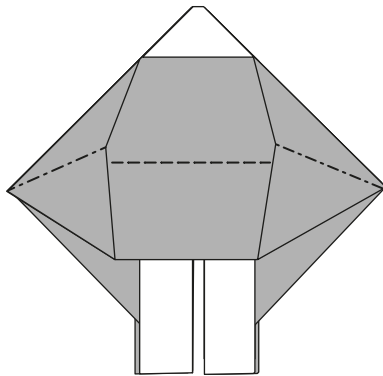
STEP 8: Fold as shown.



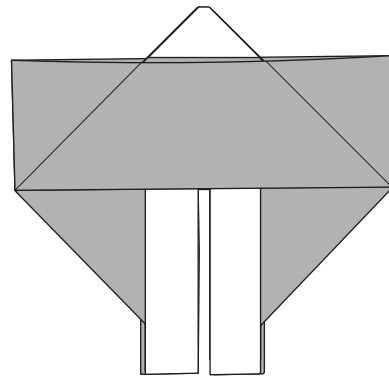
It looks like this.



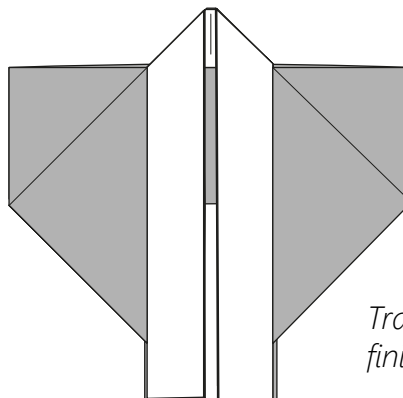
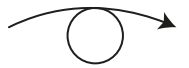
STEP 9: Open and lift the triangles on the sides. This will cause the paper layer to lift. Continue until completely folded.
