
Step 1) Start with the white side up. Fold in half and unfold.




Step 2) Fold in half the other way and unfold. Flip the paper around.




Step 3) Fold and unfold along the diagonals.



Step 4) Rotate the paper and flip it around.




Step 5) Collapse along the dotted lines to create a Square Base.




Step 6) Fold and unfold along the dotted lines.




Step 7) Bring the bottom corner, up, folding along the top horizontal line.




Bird base in progress.




Step 8) Turn the model over and repeat steps 6-7 on the back.



Step 9) Fold one flap to the left. Turn around and repeat.



Step 10) Fold the flap upwards. Repeat behind.




Step 11) Fold the left edge to the bottom edge.




Step 12) Fold 2/3 of the way up.




Step 13) Fold down to meet the edge.



Step 14) Unfold the entire flap down.




Step 15) Fold up along the back edge.




Step 16) Fold the flap back up.



Step 17) Fold down to meet the edge.




Step 18) Repeat steps 11-17 on the other side.




Step 19) Mountain fold the top flap in half. Repeat behind.



Step 20) Inside reverse fold downwards.



Step 21) Pull out the pleated wings and pull back the tail.
