


Step 1) Start with the white side up. Fold in half diagonally and unfold.




Step 2) Fold in half diagonally and unfold.




Step 3) Fold the bottom sides to the center line.




Step 4) Fold the top sides to the center line.




Step 5) Using the previous folds, collapse along the dotted lines to make a fish base.



Step 6) Mountain fold the tip back, to the same level as the circled point. Flip the model around.



Step 7) Fold the sides slightly inwards.



Step 8) Fold the model in half and rotate 90 degrees.



Step 9) Fold the small flap to the right. Repeat behind.



Step 10) Mountain fold to create the tail.
