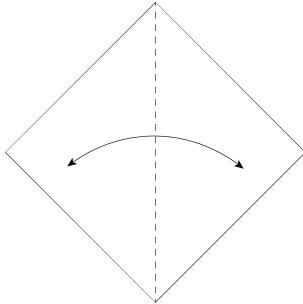


# Traditional Origami Whale

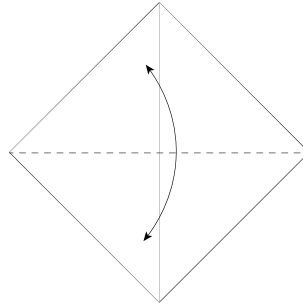

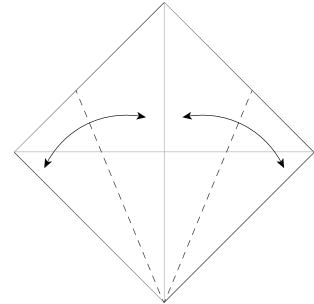

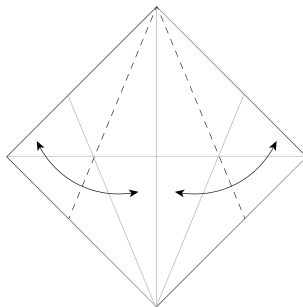
**Step 1)** Start with the white side up. Fold in half diagonally and unfold.



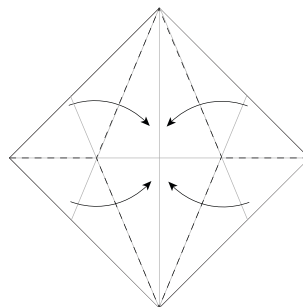
**Step 2)** Fold in half diagonally and unfold.



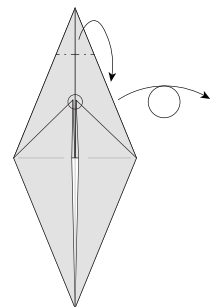
**Step 3)** Fold the bottom sides to the center line.



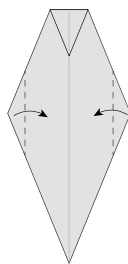
**Step 4)** Fold the top sides to the center line.



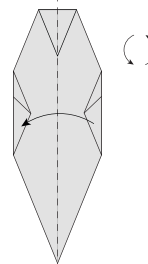
**Step 5)** Using the previous folds, collapse along the dotted lines to make a fish base.



**Step 6)** Mountain fold the tip back, to the same level as the circled point. Flip the model around.



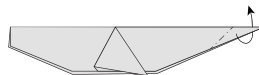
**Step 7)** Fold the sides slightly inwards.



**Step 8)** Fold the model in half and rotate 90 degrees.



**Step 9)** Fold the small flap to the right. Repeat behind.



**Step 10)** Mountain fold to create the tail.
