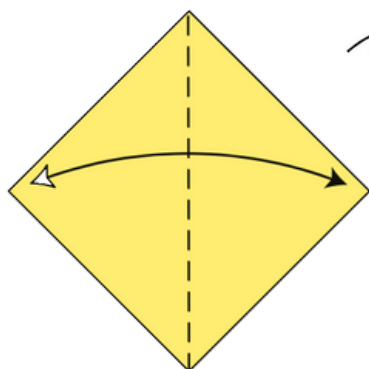
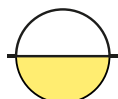


Origami Sparrow (by Simon Andersen)

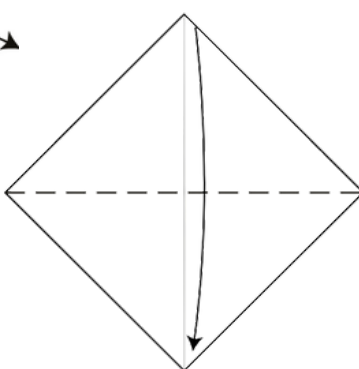

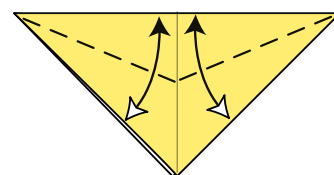

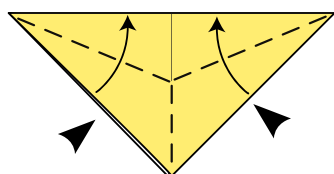
STEP 1: Start with the colored side facing up. Fold and unfold the vertical diagonal. Then, turn the paper over.



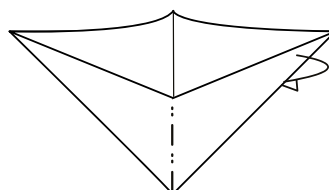
STEP 2: Fold the horizontal diagonal from top to bottom.



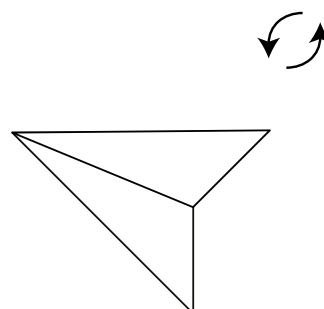
STEP 3: Fold the left and right edges up to the top edge. For each side, crease only from the corner to the centerline, then unfold.



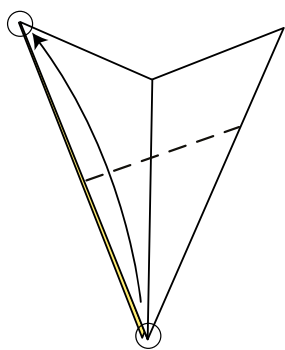
STEP 4: Fold the bottom edges of the top layer up along the creases you just made. The paper won't lie flat at this point.



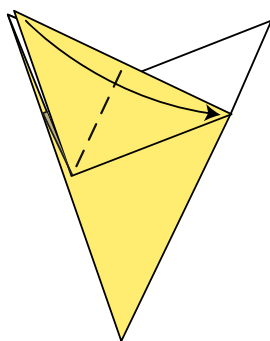
STEP 5: Mountain fold the model in half from right to left.



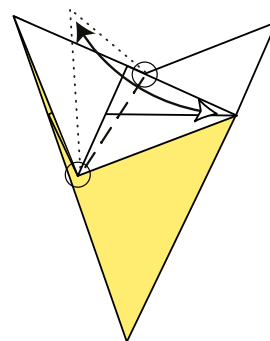
STEP 6: Rotate the model about 110° counterclockwise.



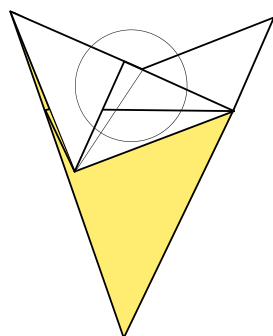
STEP 7: Fold the bottom corner up to meet the top left corner.



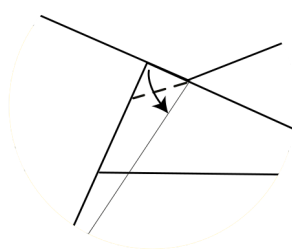
STEP 8: Fold the flap you just made in half.



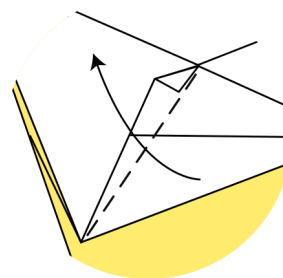
STEP 9: Fold and unfold the top flap along the dashed line. The crease should run from the bottom left corner to the point where the top two edges meet.



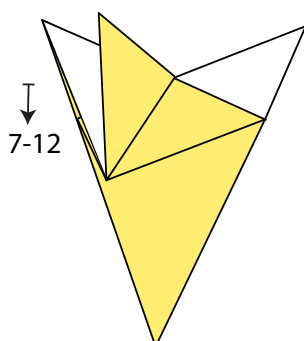
STEP 10: Zoom in



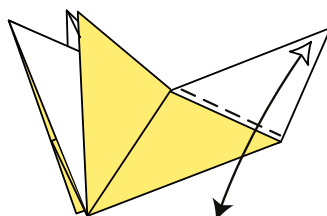
STEP 11: Fold the top corner of the flap down to meet the crease you just made.



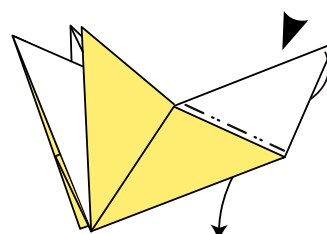
STEP 12: Fold the top flap to the left along the crease from Step 8.



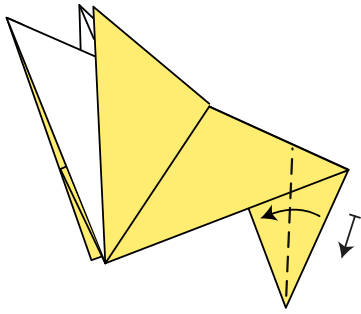
STEP 13: Repeat Steps 7 to 12 on the other side.



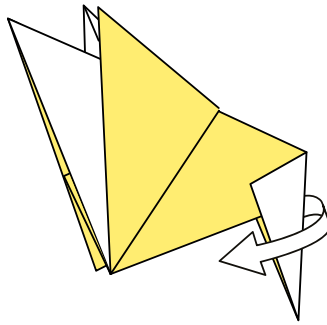
STEP 14: Fold the right triangle inward along the line where the two layers meet. Crease well, then unfold.



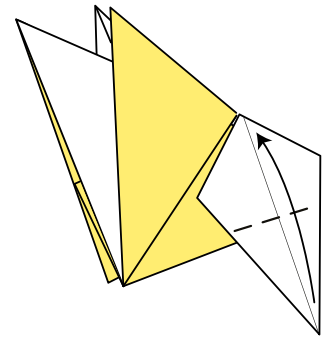
STEP 15: Inside reverse fold along the creases you just made.



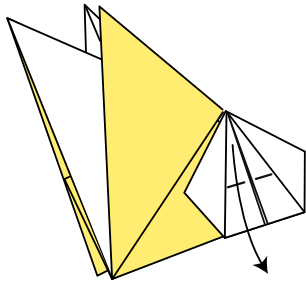
STEP 16: Fold the right edge to meet the left edge. Then, do the same on the other side.



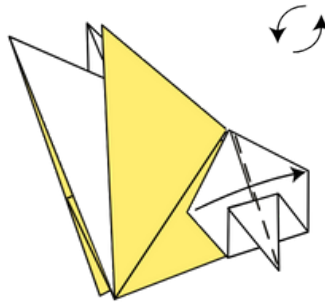
STEP 17: Flip the top flap to the left.



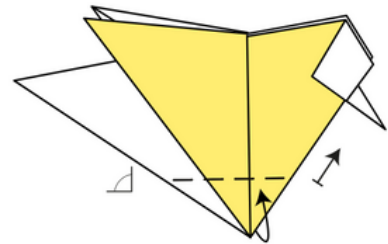
STEP 18: Fold the bottom corner up to meet the top corner.



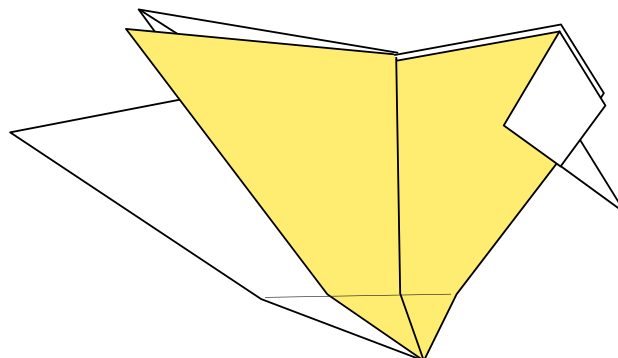
STEP 19: Fold the flap you just made down so it sticks out from the bottom edge.



STEP 20: Flip the left flap back to the right.



STEP 21: Fold the bottom corner up. Repeat on the other side so your sparrow can stand on its own.
