



Vampire Fangs (by Francesco Mancini)






STEP 1: Start with the colored side of the paper facing up. Fold and unfold along both diagonals. Then, turn the paper over.




STEP 2: Fold and unfold the top and bottom corners to the center point.




STEP 3: Fold the top and bottom corners to where the creases from Step 2 intersect with the vertical centerline.




STEP 4: Fold the bottom edge upward along the crease from Step 2.




STEP 5: Fold the top edge down to meet the top edge of the colored flap.




STEP 6: Mountain fold along the horizontal centerline.




STEP 7: Fold the right corner inward to the vertical centerline.




STEP 8: Fold the white triangle in half, from top edge to bottom edge.




STEP 9: Repeat Steps 7 and 8 on the left side.




STEP 10: Bring the flap located behind the fangs to the front.




STEP 11: Turn the model over.




STEP 12: Fold all corners inward to meet the horizontal centerline.




STEP 13: Fold the model in half, from left to right.




STEP 14: Slightly fold the top left corner inward.



STEP 15: Open the model.





STEP 16: Gently push the top section inward along the creases you just made.



The completed origami vampire mouth!


Alternative Fangs:



AFTER STEP 9:

- Mountain fold the fangs in half.
- Bring the flap behind the fangs to the front.

Then, continue with **STEP 10** as usual.
