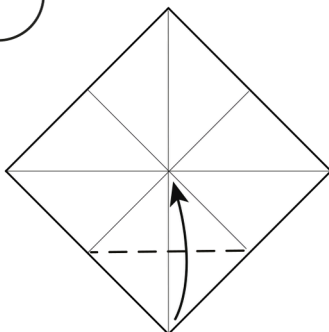
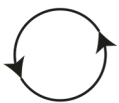
STEP 1: Start with the colored side of the paper facing you. Fold and unfold both diagonals.



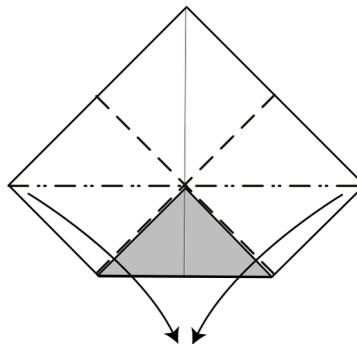
STEP 2: Turn the paper over.



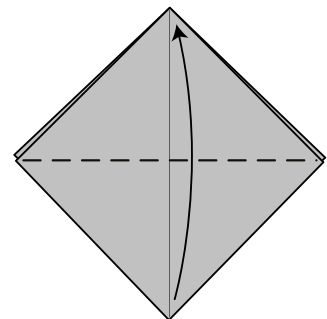
STEP 3: Fold and unfold the paper in half horizontally, then vertically.



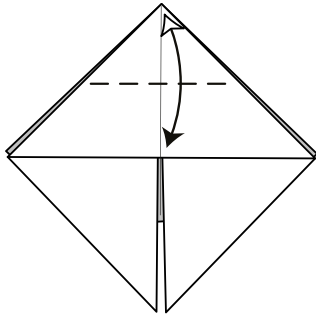
STEP 4: Fold the bottom corner up to the center point.



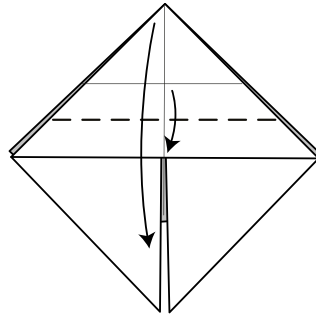
STEP 5: Collapse the model along the existing creases.



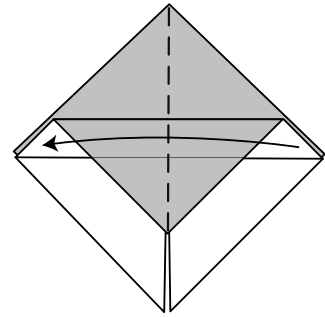
STEP 6: Fold the bottom corner up to meet the top corner.



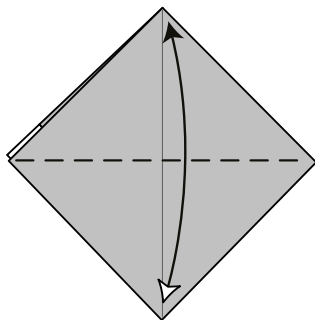
STEP 7: Fold the top corner down to meet the horizontal crease. Then unfold.



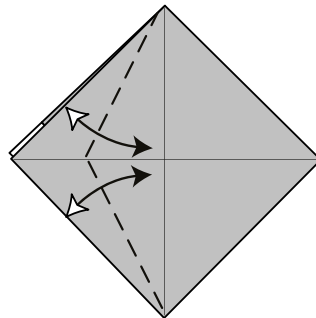
STEP 8: Fold the top corner down again. This time, the crease you just made should line up with the center horizontal crease.



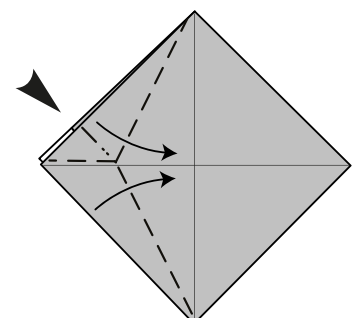
STEP 9: Flip the top right flap over to the left.



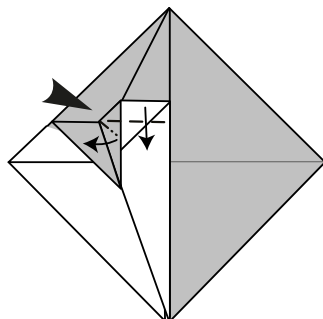
STEP 10: Fold the bottom corner up to meet the top corner. Then unfold.



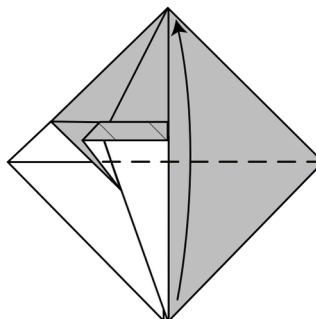
STEP 11: Fold and unfold both left edges to the centerline. Each crease should run from the corner to the horizontal centerline.



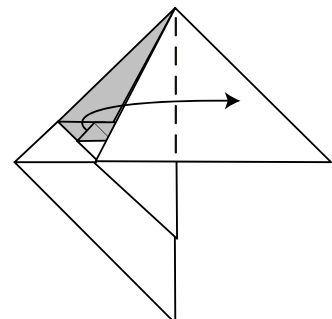
STEP 12: Fold both left edges inward at the same time, then squash the flap that's facing you upward. Its right edge should align with the vertical centerline.



STEP 13: Fold down the top edge of the flap, then swivel fold as shown.

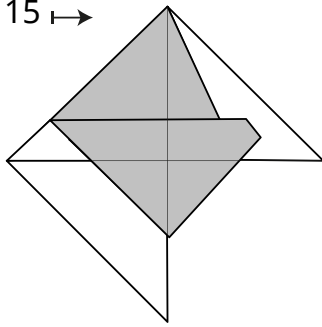


STEP 14: Fold the bottom corner up to meet the top corner.

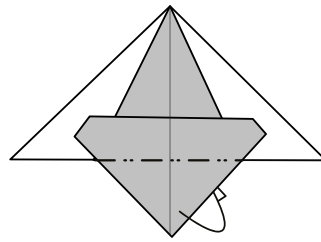


STEP 15: Flip the top left flap over to the right.

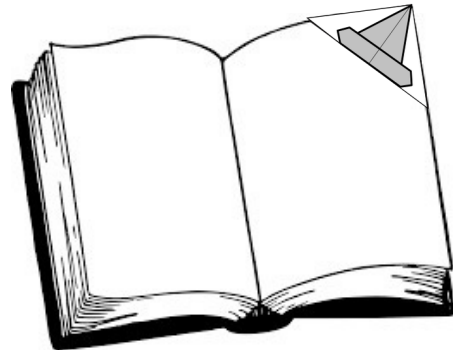
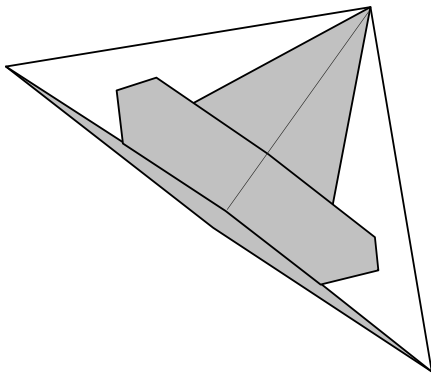

STEP 16: Repeat Steps 9 to 15 on the left side.



STEP 17: Tuck the bottom flap into the pocket, locking the flaps behind the hat together.
